DANG BUS MISHAP

50-year-old woman succumbs to injuries, accident toll rises to 6

MLA to meet authorities today with request to widen the roads

WITH A 50-year-old woman succumbing to her injuries on Monday, the death toll in the Dang district accident, in which a luxury bus carrying pilgrims from Madhya Pradesh fell into a gorge early Sunday, reached six, officials said.

The deceased has been identified as Shanti Devi Boga, who belongs to MP's Shivpuri district as the five other victims. She breathed her last at the Surat Civil Hospital. An FIR was lodged against the driver, Ratanlal Jata, who also died in the accident, for rash and negligent driving.

Meanwhile, the local BJP MLA and Deputy Chief Whip of Gujarat State Legislative Assembly, Vijay Patel, told *The Indian Express* that he will make a representation to officials in Gandhinagar on Tuesday, requesting them "to widen the roads and make corrections in the sharp curve to prevent such regular incidents of accidents."

The bus, carrying over 42 passengers from Trimbakeshwari in Nashik in Maharashtra to Dang-Valsad, Gujarat, plunged into a 25-foot-deep gorge after breaching the protection wall near the Forest Department rest house at Malegaon near Saputara in Dang – the erstwhile district to Gujarat for people coming down from Nashik – at 4:30 am on Sunday. Besides Boga and Jata [41], the other deceased were Bhagwan Kushwaha [55], Gudiya Yadav [60], Bijendra Yadav [55], and Kamlesh Yadav [60]. Over 24 passengers were severely injured in the accident.

One of the survivors, Brijesh Bhargav, lodged a complaint against the driver under sections pertaining to negligence, among others. Bhargav alleged that the driver lost control over the steering wheel after which the bus plunged into the gorge.

Vijay Patel, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) MLA from Dang, told *The Indian Express*, "Regular accidents take place in the 9-kilometre area from Malegaon downwards. The area falls under National Highways (NH), and we have been regularly making requests to them to widen the roads and make changes in the sharp curve areas. I will also make a representation to the state government and talk to the officials of NHAI in Gandhinagar on Tuesday."

Now, Patel said, the district Superintendent of Police Vishwanath Jagannath said, "There are sharp turns on narrow roads while climbing down from Malegaon area, where the incident took place. We have also deployed GRD (Gram Rakshak Dal) guards at different sharp turns, which are accident-prone areas. We have also talked to the highway authorities... The accused bus driver could not see the sharp turn as a result of which the accident took place."

Devaram Thackrey, the head of Malegaon village sarpanch Tannuwaney and one of the first responders in the accident, said, "The road climbing down (the Ghats area) from Saputara to Malegaon is quite narrow. Plus there are sharp turns as a result of which we regularly witness accidents of heavily loaded vehicles going from Nashik to Gujarat."

On the rescue operation, he said, "We are equipped with rescue equipment like two bamboo sticks holding up the corners of a bed sheet or blanket on which we carry the injured passengers. We also deploy vehicles and ropes to get deep into the gorge. After getting rescue calls, our team of 10 youths immediately reach the spot and start the rescue operation. Before police could arrive, we shifted 20 patients from the spot to nearby Shingraon PHC (Primary Health Centre)."

On the accident-prone nature of the terrain, he said, "We have complained to the district collector, police officials, political leaders, and others a number of times but nothing has been done."

Ex-deputy CM's remark on 'broking' sparks row; exposes BJP, says Cong

Remarks made during a function in Mehsana; brokers not connected with ruling party, says BJP convener

ASLUFGC has erupted over the recent purported remarks of former Deputy Chief Minister of Gujarat and senior BJP leader Nitin Patel about "brokers" who have become millionaires through "broking" with the opposition Congress alleging that his statements have "exposed" the ruling party.


Patel could not be contacted for his remarks on either row. Slamming the BJPs over Patel's statement, Congress leader Pavan Manohar Joshi said, "With his public statement (of Nitin Patel), BJPs face conduct and character stand exposed. It has been the policy of the BJP to wear the party's scarf and return the badge to the Gujarat government on Monday."

Doshi alleged that it is because of BJPs policy of letting people carry out loan and then asking them to deposit a part of it to Kamalnath (Gujarat State headquarters) that Gujarat is witnessing such scandals.

In the video, which is believed to be part of Patel's speech on the occasion, the former Deputy CM is heard saying in Gujarati: "Vanasu rajkaran may uch dalabhadha tha gya chile. Dalabhadha odukkina jode ulchan rukhvanu. BjP no hoddeta chhu. BjP no karyakar chhu, netu chhu. Adhikari karta bhau kaam kari aape, aape," roughly translated into English as, "Everyone is in politics too. Keeping acquaintances with government officers... doing work (while claiming...) as an BJP office bearer, a BJP worker or a leader. They (such brokers who are not party workers) define the party. In the name of the party, such brokers, who are not party workers, reach out to government officials in the name of the party."

Patel can also be heard saying that the government has made all (everyone) very happy. And (all) of them have become millionaires while doing broking."
